στήθος, τό	breast
φάσγανον, τό	sword
ὄξύς, -εῖα, -ύ	sharp
ξίφος, τό	sword
κόμη, ἡ	hair
ἔπος, τό	word (cf. epic)
τελέω	to bring about, carry out, accomplish; cf. τέλος, τό end, goal, purpose
παύω	stop (cf. Eng. pause)
βαρύς, -εῖα, -ύ	heavy; grievous; deep
δαίμων, -ονος	ὄ divinity
χόλος, ὁ	anger, cf. χολόω, to be angry; χύομαι, to be angry
ἄντιος, -η, -ον	opposite, facing; neut. ἄντιον, adv. = "in reply"
χαλκός, ὁ	bronze
μαλάμη, ἡ	= Lat. <i>palma</i> = Eng. palm (of the hand)
ὄρκος, τό	oath
χραιομέω	to help, avail
